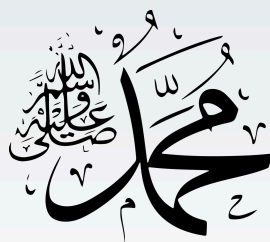

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## Importance of following the Sunnah



In Islam, when we do good deeds,  
two things must be met:

1. Sincerity to Allah
2. Accordance with the ways of the prophet ﷺ.

Following the Sunnah is extremely important. It is the way of the Messenger ﷺ, and he was the best of man.

The prophet ﷺ should be our biggest role model, and Allah says:

“Certainly, you have an excellent example in the Messenger of Allah for one who looks forward [with hope and awe] to Allah and the Last Day and who remembers Allah again and again.”

-Quran (33:21)

The Prophet ﷺ said, “I advise you to fear Allah, listen, and obey, even if an Abyssinian slave is put in charge of you. Whoever lives after me will see many conflicts. You must adhere to my Sunnah and the Sunnah of the righteous, guided successors. Hold firmly to it as if biting with your molar teeth. Beware of newly invented matters in religion, for every new matter is an innovation and, every innovation is misguidance.”
